

DEVELOPMENT OF MODEL PROGRAMS

- "Community-Based Treatment and Care Services for People Affected with Drug Use and Drug Dependence in the Philippines" – the guidance manual has already been developed with funding assistance from the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC); Barangay health workers and other community health providers/volunteers are empowered and mobilized in the prevention and control of drug abuse; Four target pilot areas for the implementation this year(2016): one each in the National Capital Region, Luzon, Visayas, and Mindanao.
- "One-Stop Shop Admission in TRCs": This is currently being done at DOH-TRC Bicutan as a pilot mechanism in facilitating easier access/ admission process for the drug dependents.
